

Wimborne Minster Town Hall Licensed for Civil Ceremonies









Our elegant Council Chamber, originally built in the 19th century, is situated within the Town Hall Grade II listed building and is available for civil ceremonies.

Our Jubilee Garden also provides a lovely location for a ceremony, photographs and celebratory toast.



- ♦ Ceremonies: Monday to Friday 2.00pm to 4.30pm or Saturday 10.00am to 4.30pm
- Your own choice of music for your wedding ceremony
- ♦ Your own choice of flowers/decorations for the table, chairs etc.....
- Although there is no parking at the Town Hall there are many car parks close by
- ♦ Access to the Council Chamber is by stairs, to the first floor
- ◆ The Town Council Weddings Officer is available for guidance in the planning of your ceremony, including support on your wedding day to guide you and your guests through your ceremony
- ♦ Civil ceremonies are legally performed by Dorset Registration Service. To contact them to book and pay their fees direct, call 01305 225153 or email registrars@dorsetcouncil.gov.uk
